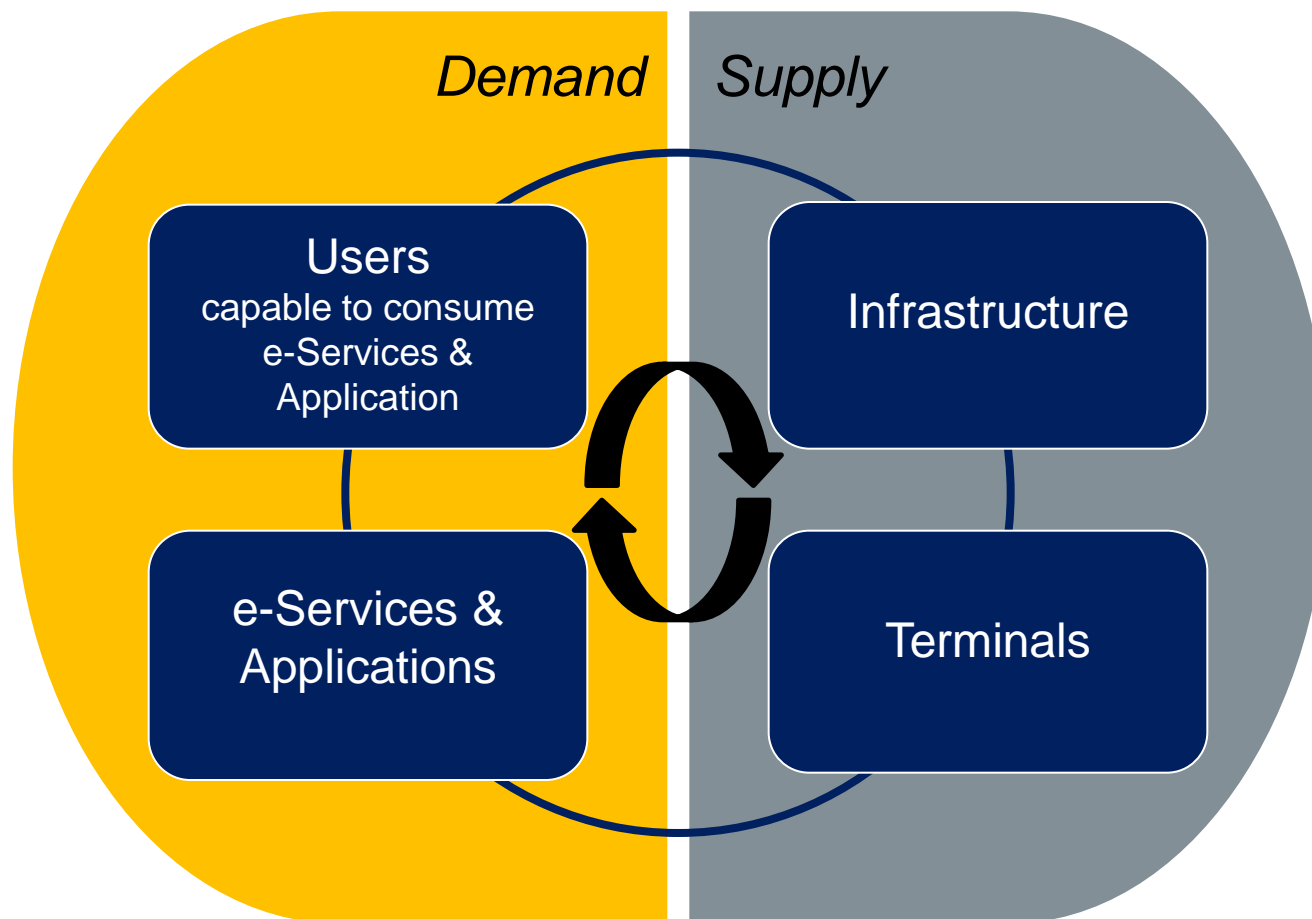

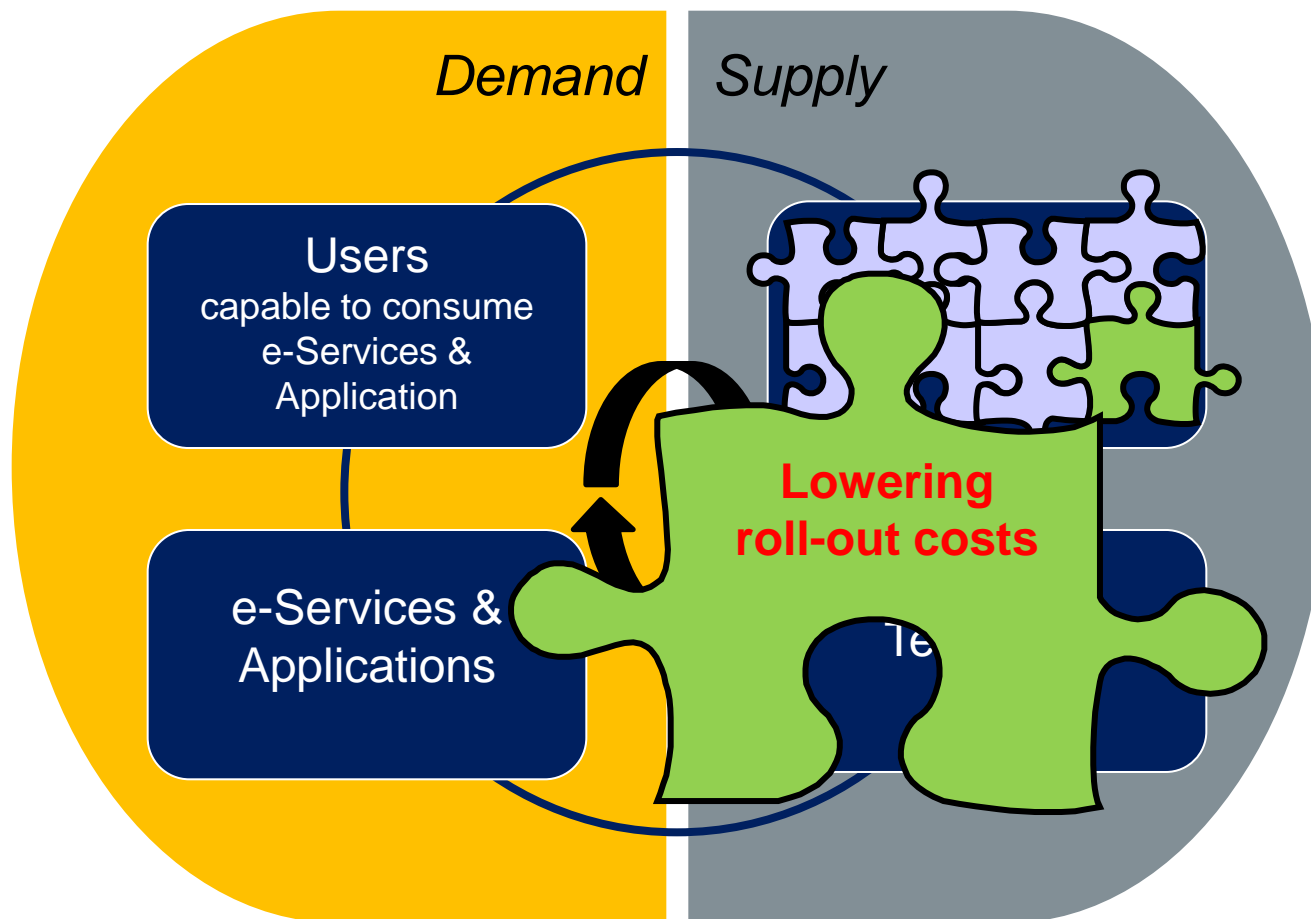
A holistic approach is needed: Access, Adoption and Usage



Activities in all areas are important to attract investments.



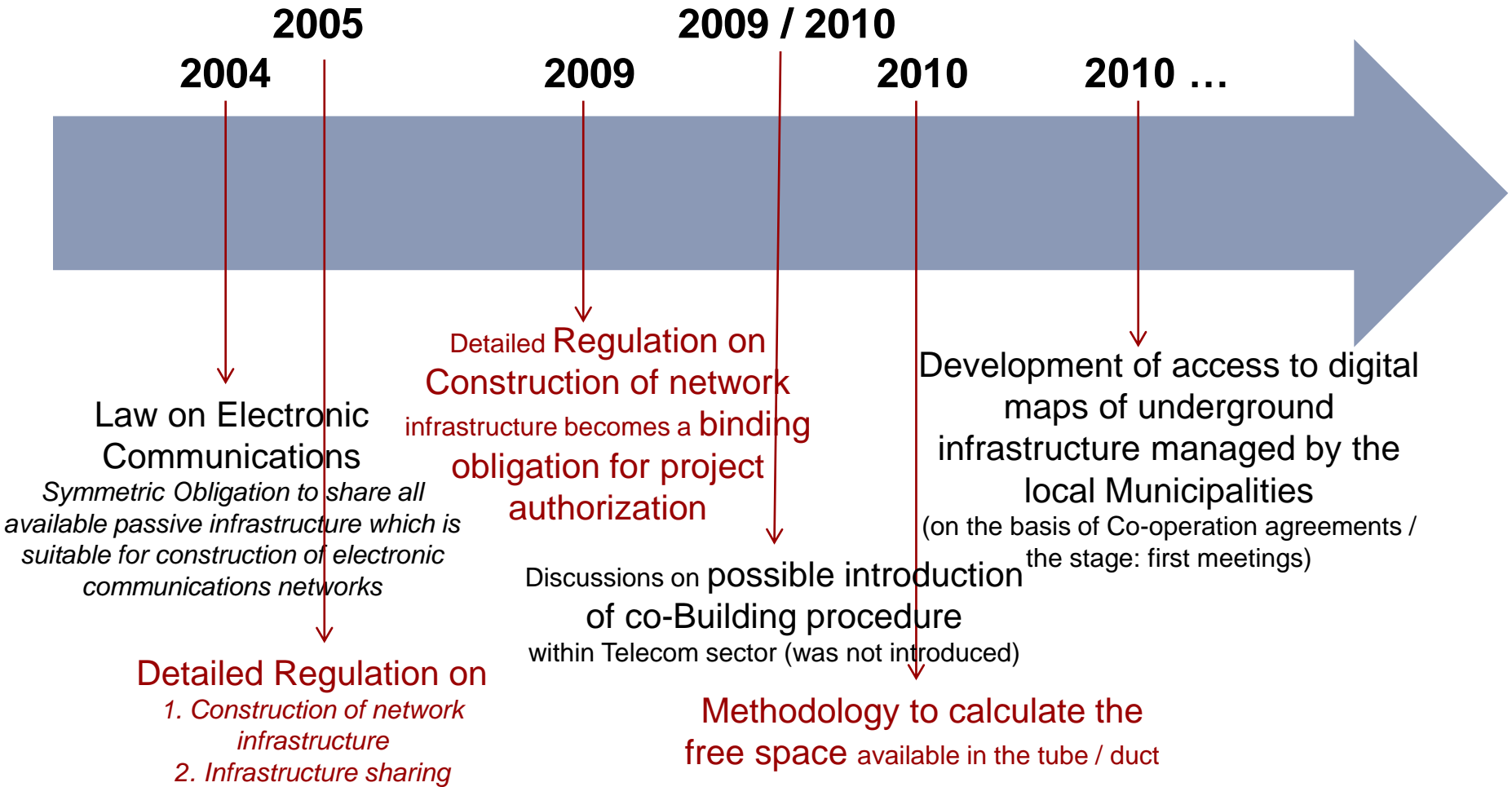
Access: LT case

Adoption: LT case





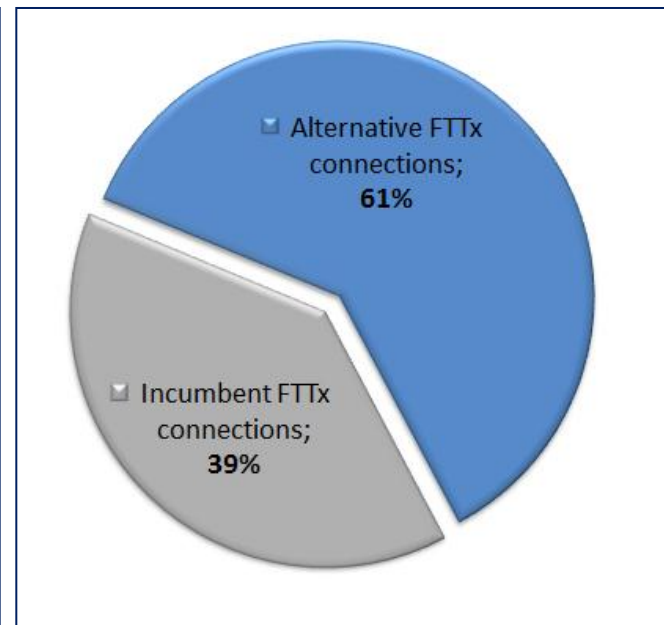
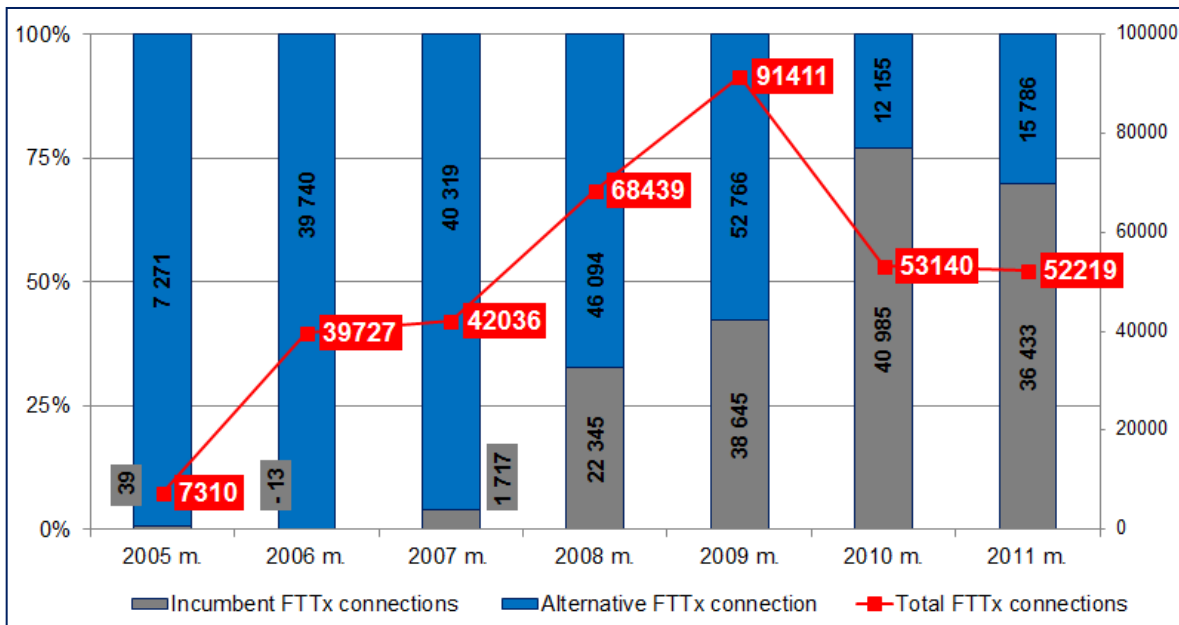
Adoption: LT case

Alternative were the first movers starting from 2005. From 2010 m. ~70% of all FTTx connections are constructed by incumbent.

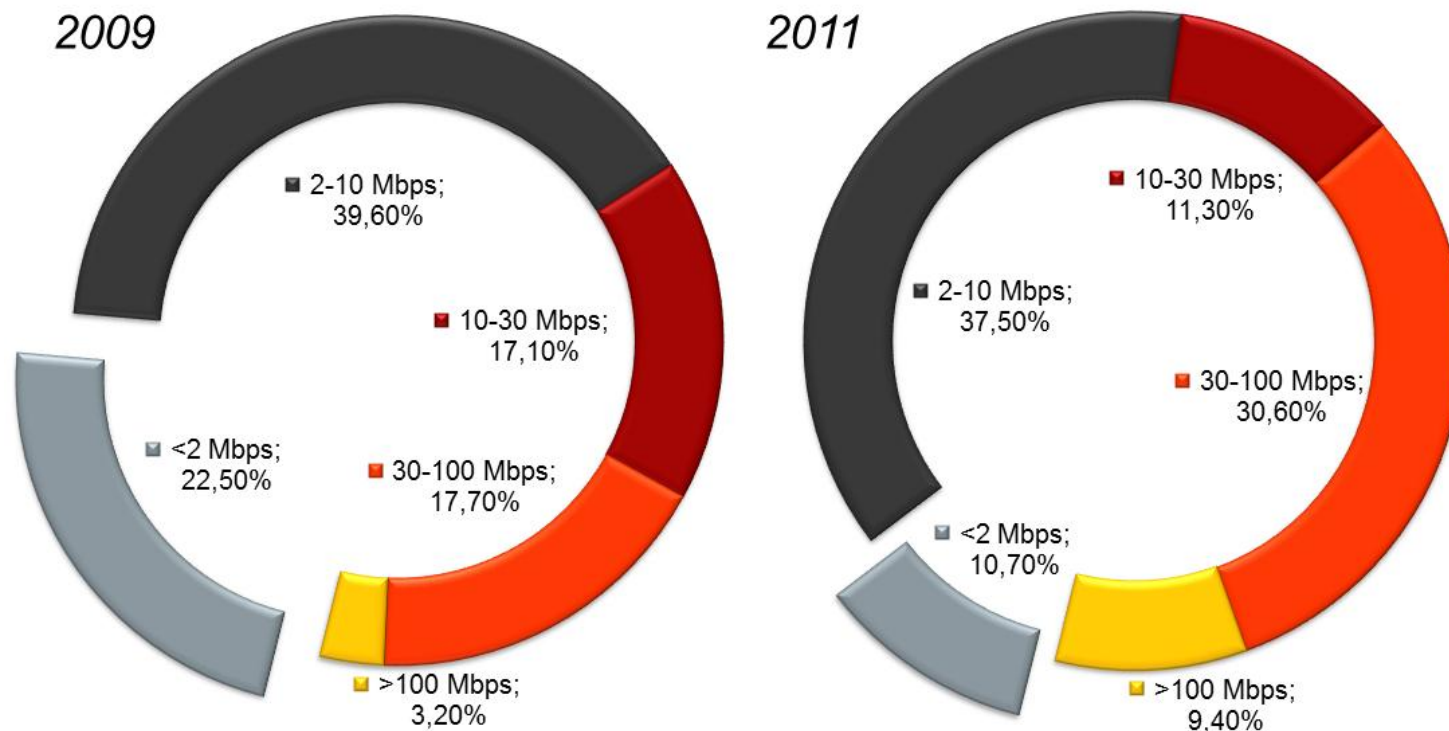


4Q 2011 m. still 61% of all FTTx connections were constructed by Alternative operators.

Access to the ducts encouraged Alternative operators to build. Today, infrastructure competition is pushing incumbent to invest.
